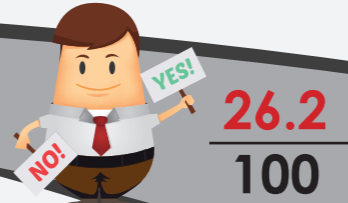
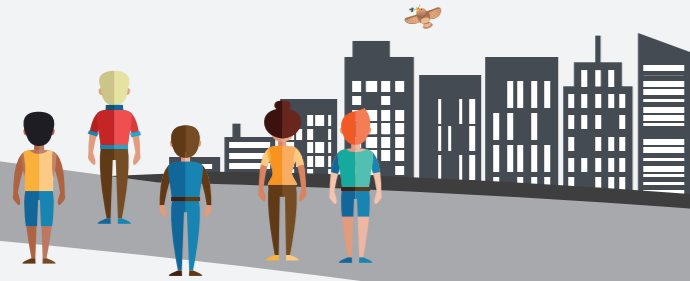


1 PRIORITIES OF GOVERNMENT vs. POPULATION'S EXPECTED PRIORITIES FROM GOVERNMENT

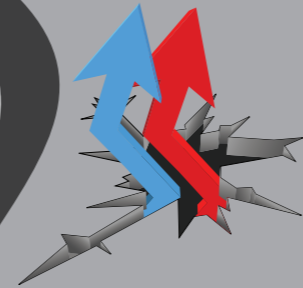
Mismatch observed across many areas. **Job creation** stands out as the only priority which is top ranked for the two dimensions used
